## Foreword

### FANZINES IN NEW ZEALAND

At the moment there are two or three fanzines in N.Z. When one considers that there are only three only known SF clubs in the country, that's not a bad record. Also, each organisation has published at least three issues of its zine, so that, within about one year, nine fanzines have been put out by N.Z. fen.

I believe that the first zine pubbed in Kiwiland was put out by Boyd Raeburn in 1943. I don't know what he called the zine, nor do I know about others being published in the years 43 - 53.

Here's a brief background to fanzine pubbing in recent years in New Zealand:-

The first fanzine of the present boom in Kiwiland was either SFICION from the Auckland Space Club, then called the Junior Space Club, or MAGNITUDE from the Christchurch SF Group. I've seen and read both of these scraps and possibly the least said about them the better you'll feel. However I'll just say that SFICION was a five page Fordigraphed affair containing little more than a useful three addresses, and that MAGNITUDE was a four page duped job containing virtually nothing!

Next zine to appear was FOCUS, in which "Spacemanship" appeared and drew the attention of several people in the U.S.A. and England. Focus 1 was a ½-fcp Gestetnered packet of 24 pages. About 50 copies were posted abroad and about 8 replies have been received here in Wellington. The reception was decidedly cool. This was near the end of '55.

About a month after this first appearance of FOCUS, a NOVA (used to be SFiction) burst upon the scene. The editor gave us the explanation for the title, "(A nova is a new star rapidly growing in brilliance!)", to which I can only add "(!!!)". Anyway, Nova 2 contained two short stories, some 'orrible poetry, and another two pages of nothing.

If there was a second issue of MAGNITUDE, I never did see it, so I'll skip the gap and go on with SPACE DUST 3 (which used to be MAGNITUDE). Maybe I'd better skip that also, as it was little better than MAGNITUDE and yet claimed to be "New Zealand's foremost fanzine!" Ah well. . .

On to NOVA number three and FOCUS number 2. NOVA was completely changed. It now had 15 pages (fcp) and contained one good short story, several articles and features an SF version of a popular song. FOCUS 2 was produced on the same format as its predecessor and contained two short stories.

Well, that's the history, at present, of N.Z. fanzine publishing. There is word that before SFICITION came on the scene, there was a thing called the ROCKET MAG. But I haven't seen this thing yet, so let's have a look at the future:

Nova 4, according to its editor, will be on the same format as this current FOCUS. Accordingly, other changes have been made. For example, it'll consist of 28 pages and be dittoed. This is said mainly with crossed fingers, but I see no reason why all should not work out as planned.

FOCUS, as can be seen, has also changed to quarto format, also, we're attempting to use different styles of stencil cutting and lettering are going to be attempted. One day it is hoped, moderate amounts of coloured inks and papers will be used in this fanzine--one day . . .

SPACE DUST (who mentioned DEBRIS?), so far has not had a fourth issue. Maybe it;s dropped out of the running.

## Introduction

When I first entered Science Fiction fandom back in the early part of 1979, I had no idea about what this 'sub genre' was all about. Indeed ever since I became interested in this sometimes fantastic, sometimes weird field of literature I was convinced totally that I was alone in my interest.

Encountering others who held writers like Asimov, Clarke and Norton in the same high regard that I did, was very heartening and extremely encouraging in that I now knew that when I retreated into this world of space-ships and bug-eyed monsters my dreams were being shared by others around the world.

Through my involvement in several local groups I became interested in the many 'Amateur SF Magazines' being produced by my fellow fen. They told of a rich and wonderful way of life, the eccentricity of fans, their elaborate customs and rituals and above all they spoke greatly about fandom's beginnings in the 1920's.

One such fanzine- Noumenon, carried an article on a New Zealand fan during the fifties that intrigued me so much I contacted the editor Brian Thurogood, with a view to finding out more on New Zealand's fannish history. To my surprise I found out that apart from what was mentioned in the article, nothing else was known about SF fandom in NZ.

Brian was involved at the time in organising New Zealand's first SF convention to be held over Labour Weekend, 1979. Because of my enthusiasm and interest, Brian offered me the task of researching and writing an article for the convention book on New Zealand's fannish past, to which I accepted.

It was now July 1979 and armed with one name and a telephone number, I set to work. Roger Horrocks turned out to be a wealth of information, his recollection of events, people and organisations was to be extremely instrumental in the success of the venture.

The old fanzines I obtained from him provided more information, and through them I started contacting some of the fans who had been active in past years. This turned out to be a task that required a lot more time than I had originally expected.

But, by September things were going relatively smoothly, and it wasn't long before the article was finished and safely delivered to Brian for publication. After it was published I started to collect more material for a followup article that Brian wanted to include in the Post Convention booklet, after many delays it was finally published as a four page insert in Noumenon.

The interest that these two pieces generated was enough to write another short article for the Wellcon B convention book. Wellcon B was my first SF convention and since it was being held in Wellington it presented me with an ideal opportunity to meet some of the fans who had been supplying me with information for the Histories.

It was these meetings and new research that culminated in the decision to re-write the original articles and publish them in one concise work in time for the 1981 NZ National SF Convention, this time being held in Auckland.

When it was finally put together and published at the convention I had spent almost two years on the project and many dozens of hours researching information for it. My aim was to followup this volume with a secondary one later that year with the balance of the material, and then to forget the whole thing. But, as fate would have it the second volume was never published no matter how many times I promised that it would.

This volume then is the result of nearly four years on the venture. It is what I would like to have achieved back in September 1979, but lacking then in the skills and resources that the last four years have provided me with, this was not possible.

This has been something of a labour of love for me and I fully intend to carry on collecting information on our 'past', for possible publication in the annual supplements that I intend to produce in order to keep this work current.

I have already commenced work on writing "timeless sands Volume 2" which will complete the work. This will concentrate on the events, people and groups within SF fandom in New Zealand over the last 50 years and will hopefully provide an insight into these times, especially in the years prior to man in space.

## Explanatory Notes

All the fanzines are listed in Chronological order according to the month of each issue. Zines which had no date or numbering system are listed in the order that they appeared.

The list has been split into two parts to facilitate the locating of specific fanzines; widely available fanzines including all club magazines, news-zines, personal and general SF fanzines; and Apa-zines [Fanzines specifically produced for an Amateur Publishing Association (APA)].

Some confusion has arisen over the editorship of certain fanzines. Where this has happened I have taken the editorship credit directly from the fanzine in mention. However, to be as fair as possible I have tried to give the editor's names in order of importance.

Throughout the listings I have added at the foot of some pages additional information relevant to that page. Appendix 2 at the end of this work is an alphabetical listing of all fanzine titles and contains further details on the zines listed.

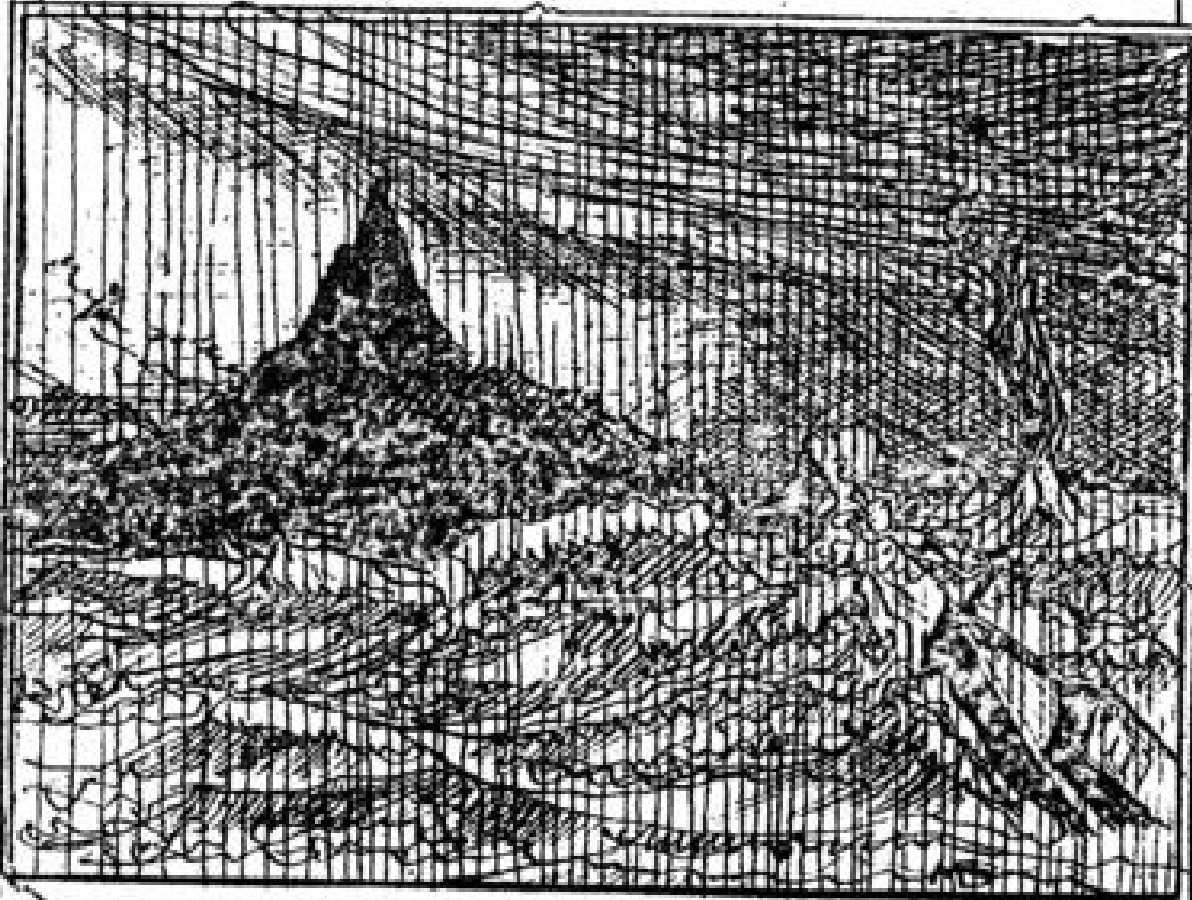

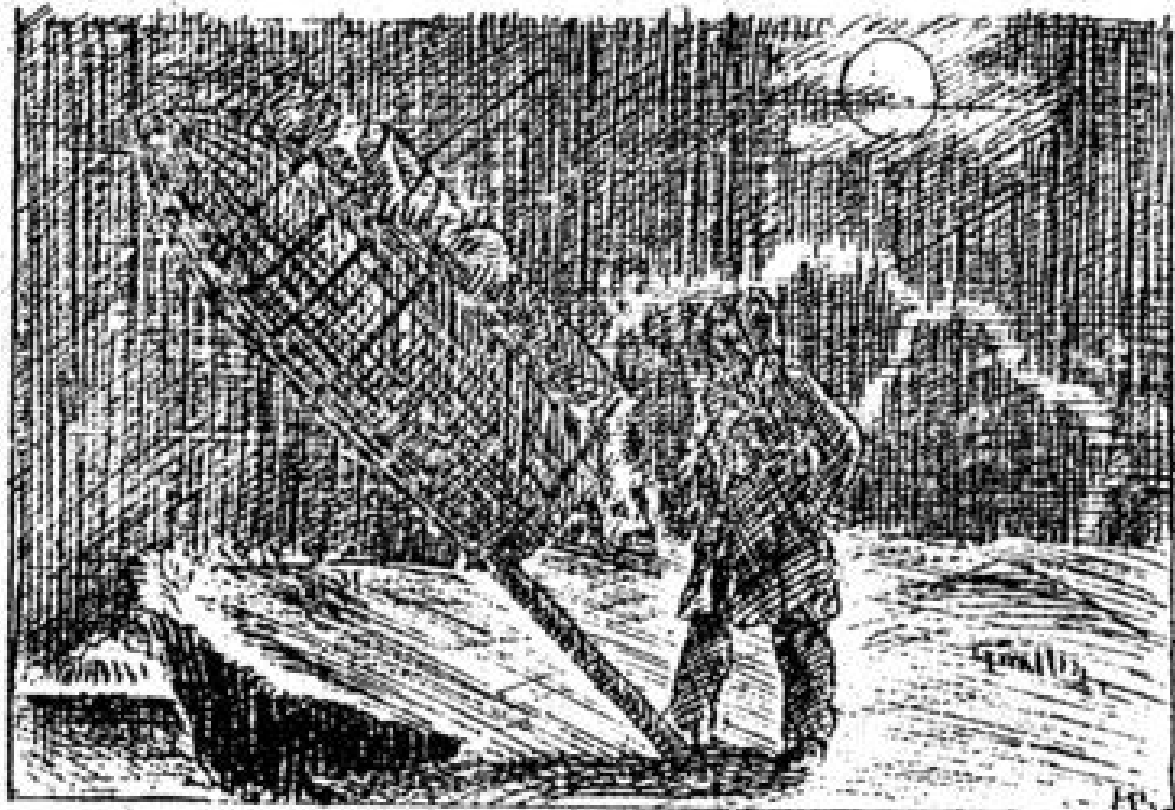

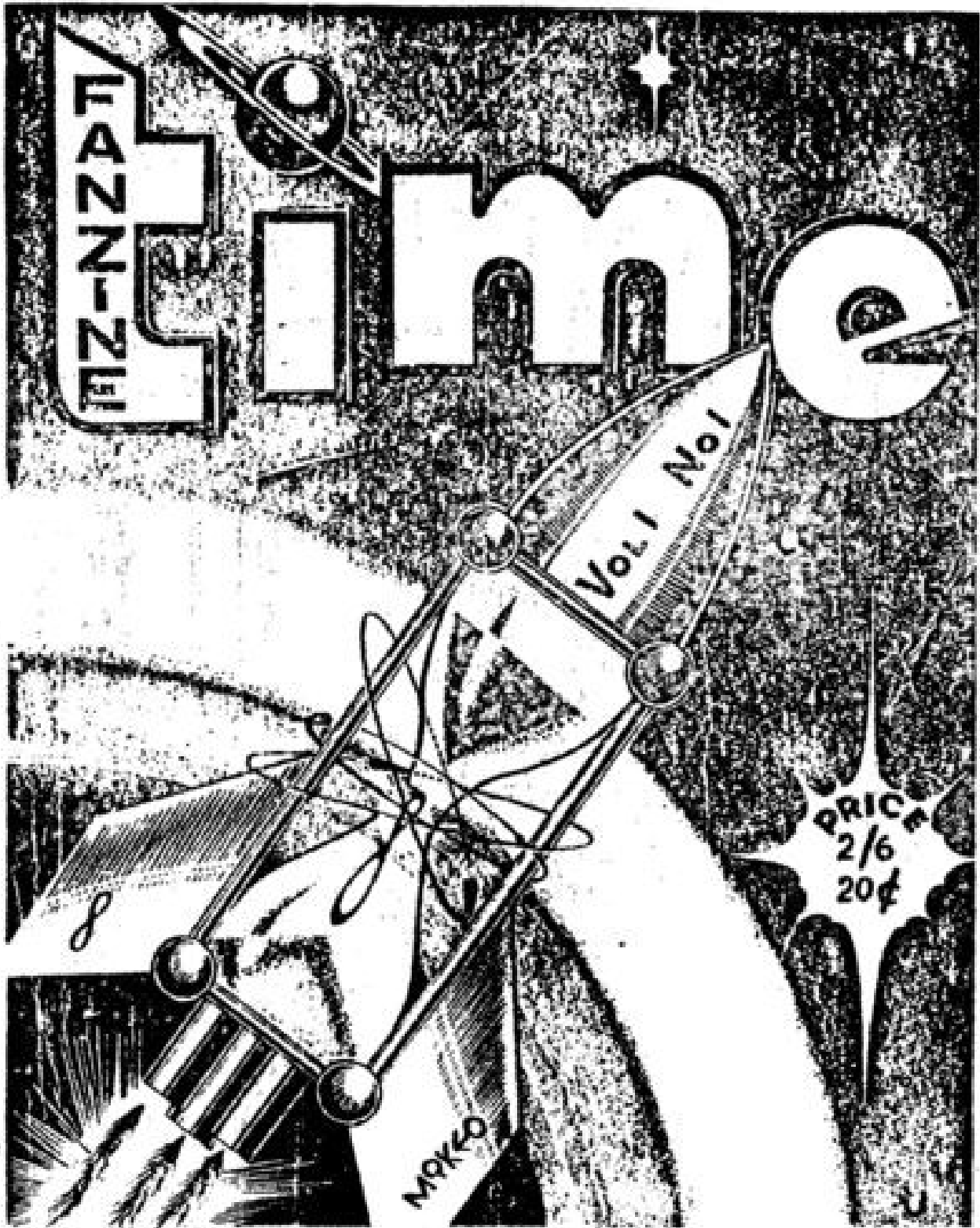

The arrangement of the index is fairly straightforward, no abbreviations are used and standard bibliographic elements are included in the citation: author, article title, journal title, volume number, issue number, pages, month and year.

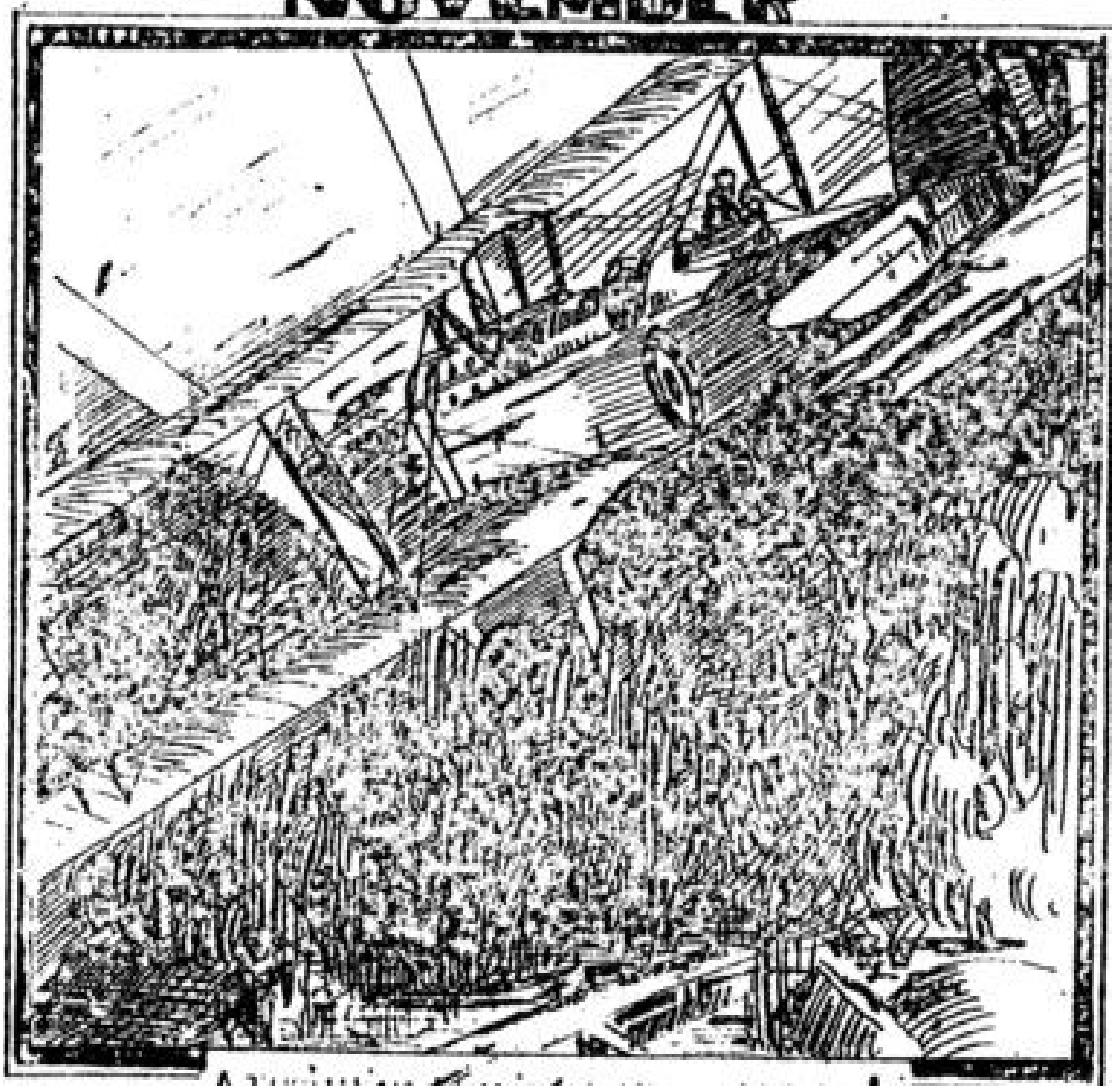

## Appendix One

### The Fanzines That Never Made it

Through all the years of fanzine publishing, there have been several ventures that have never gotten further than the drawing board, or in some cases, a fanzine has been completely prepared and then never printed. In all these cases very little is known about the zines in question. In the list that follows I have strived to present a complete a picture as is possible.

§§§§§§

APOTHEOSIS was never published, although the cover and back page exist in a Gestetnered format, as well as the original cover artwork. The Editor was to be Ricky Paris, and the Art Editor - Toni Vondruska.

- ARROW Issues 19 and 20 were prepared to the following degrees; Issue 19 was made up into a 64 pg format, 29 pages including the cover are complete with headings and content. All the other pages are ready only to the extent that they carry headlines. Issue 20 only the cover and page headings exist.
- BOMBED BUDGIE JOURNAL An unused version of the front page for issue 9 exists in a printed format.
- COSMIC CHAOS CLUB NEWSLETTER A four page original exists for the unpublished issue 2. One or two copies of this were distributed to some fans.
- ECHH This fanzine exists in spirit only. It was intended to be published by Bruce Burn.
- FROM DOWN UNDER A three page zine produced by Greg Hills for inclusion in a copy of The National Fantasy Fan (USA fanzine). A 3 page original exists dated July 1980 but never published.
- KIWIFAN 10 The most famous of all unpublished kiwi-zines. The editor Roger Horrocks fully intended producing this issue but other commitments got in the way. Bruce Burn published issue 11 in the hope that this would prompt Roger into action, but to no avail. Several printed pages exist, 20 to be exact. Including a long story by Cavel Nichop that was originally written for a SF Story Magazine Roger was preparing.
- KIWIFAN 13 Greg Hills put the sub-title of Kiwifan 12 on the first issue of Terminus. A month later, Greg typed up two stencils for Kiwifan 13 (December 1979).
- E:175 - S:40 Two pages were typed up by Greg Hills for this apa-zine in 1979.
- MACCENT Another fanzine that was widely rumoured to be published by John McLeod. alas this was not to be.

THE MAGIC STYLUS Was an idea of Bruce Burn for a one-shot fanzine in the tradition of "The Enchanted Duplicator". The one-shot never eventuated but the story ended up being published in paraFANalia 4 - PT.1 and paraFANalia 6- PT.2. The rest of the story remains unpublished and unwritten(?). The plot-outline is quite interesting; "Tru Fann is presented with a Magic Stylus by the great Ghod Gestetner. Tru Fann is the step-daughter of the King of Subberland. Sir Con decided he wants it and allys himself with Tru's step-father, Klub fan, the evil, double talking king of Subberland. They both envy her and want the Stylus. A Knight-in-shining-armor enters the land. He is called An Pubber...." Perhaps Bruce could be persuaded to write the rest...?

MAINZINE 1 Was produced by Greg Hills in November 1979 as a four page zine to go through all the APAs he was a member of. Never published although the four page original exists in a photo-reduced format and the original pages.

NO CORFLU BLUES was typed up onto two stencils and printed by Greg Hills but never distributed.

SF STORY MAGAZINE Was proposed by Roger Horrocks in July 1959, around the same time that Kivifan 10 was still an 'on' proposition. Cavel Nichol to type up the stencils for a 15 page story he was going to put through it. The stencils were typed and some copies were printed from them, but the magazine was never published.

SLINK Rumoured at some time to be a fanzine Lynette Mills was working upon.

SLURG Ditto. although this time the perpetrator was Peter Davies.

SPLUTTER 2 The second issue from the hoax club "The Seatoun SF Society" which Bruce Burn created. An 8 page original exists. dated January 1958. Carries one or two interesting revelations from Bruce.

TANJENT 11 When T11 was finally published by Greg Hills, it was a substantially different version to the one that Greg had originally proposed five months earlier, in June 1980. A photo-reduced photo-copy edition of the first version exists at 28pgs in length.

WELLCON B ONE-SHOT A collection of reminiscences relating to Wellcon B, intended for distribution through N'APA by Greg Hills. Seven pages were completed, altho' only five are known to exist.

WORLDS BEYOND Obviously Tom Cardy intended at some time to publish a 12th edition of WB, as Gestetnered copies of a cover exist.

**AUCKLAND SCIENCE FICTION LEAGUE NEWSLETTER:** Clubzine; Auckland SF League/Akld branch of the National Assn. for SF. Editor is Don Burch. [Auckland 1982]

**BEMAOH BROADCASTS:** Clubzine; Bug-Eyed Monsters are only Human Society. Editor was Mike Jenkins. [Whangarei 1980]

**BEYOND THE HYADES:** Personal fanzine with emphasis on the Darkover novels. Most issues do not carry any date or numbering system and for a time it was impossible to collate them in any sequence. But, this has not been achieved and the following is a guide only; (Note: From issue 4 the serial Janyl started, each successive installment was numbered; so this in itself helps.

- BTH-1: Mentioned the fact that it was the first issue.
- BTH-2: ditto
- BTH-3: Had drawings of two females on the cover, a chart showing distances between star systems and a piece on what we will be eating in the future.
- BTH-3.5: Was numbered 3 by mistake.
- BTH-4: Features a map on the cover of what is 'Beyond the Hyades'
- BTH-5: On the cover there is two photos of Peter Graham, and inside a review of the SF issue of Pacific Quarterly Moana.
- BTH-6: Comic sequence on the cover and back page, and contains the story 'Torch'.
- BTH-7: Contains articles on Maori Astronomy, Fanagrams.
- BTH-8: Has on the cover three Maoris and inside is an article on a game called 'Chobche'.
- BTH-9: Has on the cover an astrological chart and photo of Peter Graham.
- BTH-10: ???
- BTH-11: Is dated July 1980 (Actually published in August).
- BTH-12: Is subtitled 'I. Tua O Te Ra O Tainui' and has on the cover a star map and information on the Maori canoe Tainui.
- BTH-13: Features on the cover a female sitting in front of a three-dimensional chess set. [Auckland 1978]

SNEETCHE: Genzine. Editor is Graham Ferner. [Auckland 1983]

SPACEDUST: see MAGNITUDE

SCIENTIFIA: Magazine of the Auckland District SF Society. Edited by Bruce Burn. Published in New Zealand. First issue 1974. [Auckland 1974-1975]

STANZA NEWSLETTER: Clubzine; Star Trek Association of New Zealand. Editor was Peter Sumnovich. Lasted for two issues before it was incorporated into the other club magazine He's Dead Jim. [Auckland 1980]

STRIPS: Comics fanzine. Editor is David Morgan. Editor for issues 1-11 was Rollo Treadway, and issue 16 was guest-edited by Mike Jaynapall. [Auckland 1976]

TANJENT: Clubzine of the SF Fan Confederation until issue 9, when it became a genzine. Editor is Greg Hills. [Wanganui 1-10, Wellington 11-]

TANSTAFF: Newsletter of the SF Film Festival Society, which was set up to organise a SF Film Festival in 1981. When the festival was cancelled the newsletter ceased. Editor was David White. [Wellington 1980]

TERMINUS: Newszine. Editor was Greg Hills. The first issue was sub-titled Kiwifan 12. [Wanganui 1979]

TESSERACT: Genzine. Editors were Peter Graham and Debi Kean. [Auckland 1979]

WELLCON B BULLETIN: Newsletter for Welcon B SF Con. Although the title has been used to publish several other newsletters to take advantage of postal regulations. Issues 1-4 were for the convention itself, issue 5 was subtitled TANSTAFF 2, issues 6 & 7 were produced for Australasicon 1 and Windycon '83 respectively. The editor for all except 5 was Greg Hills. [Wellington 1980]

WELLS CLUB BULLETIN: Clubzine; Wells Club. The editors were David Donaldson and David Lee-Smith. [Invercargill 1977]

WHEREVER YOU MAY BE (WEYMB): Fan Address Listing. Editor is Greg Hills. Only two issues were produced, although two pages were given to WEYMB in Terminus 1. [Wanganui 1978]

[Peter Graham published two other fanzines of whom I know nothing except their names; Vaurela and ARA (which I know was published in 1980).]
